

*Comunitatea românească din estul Serbiei. Studiu geografic
(Romanian community in eastern Serbia. Geographical study)*

The work published by the “Eudoxiu Hurmuzachi” Institute constitutes a special geographic paper within the present geopolitical context.

This geographical work reflects a strong ethnic analysis about the social situation of the Romanian community in eastern Serbia.

The study argues for the authenticity of the neo-Latin ethnic group located throughout the space of the Danube River.

The results of the diachronic analysis emphasize the influences of other nations on the Romanian ethnic group located in eastern Serbia, through “necessary borrows” and imposed changes (rarely with tacit consent or involuntary derogations, in a multicultural context). The author evidences also the ethnographic originality of the Romanian community within the European regionalization paradigm.

This volume contributes to a better knowledge about the present reality of the Romanian community in eastern Serbia and explains problems generated within a multiethnic society.
